The Parade Company is seeking high school and collegiate marching bands to participate in the 2010 America's Thanksgiving Parade®! The Parade Selection Committee selects units based on their performance and quality of music as well as the band's overall presentation.

Applications must be completed in full to be considered for acceptance and must be submitted no later than Tuesday, June 2, 2010.

Upon reviewing applications, units will be notified of their status in writing no later than Friday, July 9, 2010. (Dates are subject to change). Selected units are responsible for all transportation, accommodations and all other expenses while in Detroit. Each unit is also encouraged to purchase a minimum ten (10) grandstand seats at \$15.00 each totaling \$150.00.



All commercial units may contact our sponsorship department for further information on participating in America's Thanksgiving Parade®. A unit is identified as commercial if the entry is a promotion of a commercial venture, or recognizes any other entity, organization or business other than itself.

America's Thanksgiving Parade® will step off at Woodward and Mack Avenue on Thursday, November 25, 2010 at 9:20am. The Parade Route is 1.5 miles of smiles along Woodward Avenue from Mack to Congress. The Parade is broadcast live and nationally syndicated throughout 74.5 million households.
